Srivastava Ld counsel for the respondent bank is present through VC.</p> <p>Ld counsel for the applicant is pressing I.A No. 11/2026 early hearing application, I.A. No. 30/2026 amendment application in view of sale notice and I.A. No. 12/2026 stay application for restraining the respondent bank from putting the property on e-auction on 19.01.2026.</p> <p>The only arguments raised by the applicant is that case is ripe for disposal and applicant wants to settle the account.</p> <p>Ld counsel for the respondent bank vehemently opposed the move of applicant. It is submitted that copy early hearing served to the respondent bank only yesterday.</p> <p>In view of fact that sale is fixed for 19.01.2026, it is made clear that any action of the respondent bank shall be subject to final outcome of the SA and respondent bank shall not take steps for registration of sale certificate without approval of this Tribunal.</p> <p>If respondent bank fails to auction the property in e-auction, applicant will be at liberty to approach the respondent for proper settlement.</p> <p>Both the parties are directed to prepare himself for final arguments. Matter is adjourned.
